Jennifer Duff is currently Program Director, Mental Health at Providence Health Care. Jennifer was selected as a top emerging leader across Canada, under the age of 40, as the recipient of the 2011 Emerging Leader Scholarship. Sponsored by ARAMARK, Emerging Health Leaders(EHL) and the Canadian College of Health Leaders (CCHL), Jennifer traveled to Sweden with health care leaders across Canada to explore current developments in the Swedish health system. Join us for Jennifer's presentation and learnings from the Sweden Study Tour and explore why Sweden is regarded as one of the world's best providers of health care. Jennifer will provide comparisons to our Canadian system as well as share some lessons in mentorship from the Sweden Study Tour.

Jennifer began her career as a Registered Nurse working with patients undergoing surgery and in maternity. After completing her Master of Health Administration, she completed a residency at Providence Health Care (PHC) with the Office of the CEO and gained experience on several clinical projects with PHC. She currently is Program Director, Mental Health at PHC and prior to this she was Operations Leader, Maternity Services Program at PHC where she led a lean review and redesign of the program resulting in the implementation of over 160 initiatives. She is a Certified Health Executive (CHE) was named one of Business in Vancouver's Top 40 under 40 in 2011 and was awarded the Robert Zed Young Leader Award in 2012 by the Canadian College of Health Leaders.
