Barry Rivelis is Chief Information Officer of the Provincial Health Services Authority (PHSA), Vancouver Coastal Health and Providence Health Care. He is responsible for overall technology strategy and information management services at facilities such as BC Children's and Women's Hospital, BC Cancer Agency, Vancouver General Hospital, St. Paul's Hospital, and the BC Centre for Disease Control. Before joining PHSA, Mr. Rivelis was a Vice President at TELUS from 2004 to 2009, where he led their expansion into the Canadian healthcare IT industry. Before that, he was a vice president at Cap Gemini Ernst & Young in Vancouver, and a partner with Ernst & Young Consulting in Toronto from 1994 to 2004. He is a member of the Canadian Health Information Executive Forum, where he sits on the Executive Advisory Board, a member of the Board of the Jewish Family Services Agency of Vancouver and is a past member of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce and the ITAC Health Board of Directors. Mr. Rivelis holds a BA in Economics from York University and an MBA from the Schulich School of Business.
