TOPIC: Providing healthcare on the battlefield is dangerous and extremely challenging. This session will address issues for healthcare providers and leaders such as:

- How to deal with stress and burnout
- Ethical dilemmas with provision of care in a resource and time constrained environment
- Coping strategies
- Lessons learned for Canadian providers from administering health care on a battlefield
- Fact and folklore about the experience

Our speakers will share their experiences of running a multinational trauma hospital from their posts abroad, including in Afghanistan. This promises to be an informative and interactive session.

SPEAKER: Major James Bradley, Commanding Officer, 31 CF Health Services Centre Borden

Major Bradley has served in 1 Canadian Field Hospital, with the Joint Support Group Headquarters in Kingston, as Officer Commanding Closure Squadron for the Mission Close-out Team in Bosnia (SFOR), in various staff positions in CF Health Services Group Headquarters, including as the medical planner in Canadian Operational Support Command and then Canadian Expeditionary Forces Command. He was the lead medical planner for the earthquake relief in Haiti, for the close-out of the mission in Kandahar, the stand-up of the mission in Kabul, and the Libya mission. He served as Deputy Commanding Officer of the Role 3 Multinational Medical Unit in Kandahar, Afghanistan.

Captain Lacombe is assigned the flight surgeon's position at 31st Canadian Forces Health Services Centre. During that same posting, she was deployed to Kandahar with Task Force 03-10 from November 2010 to July 2011 as a flight surgeon.
