Collaborative care has been commonly understood as occurring when “multiple health workers from different professional backgrounds provide comprehensive services by working with patients, their families, careers and communities to deliver the highest quality of care across settings. Mounting evidence links interprofessional collaborative care to improved patient outcomes, enhanced patient safety, increased patient/health provider satisfaction with care, and increased health system efficiency. The need to ensure safe, high quality patient care with increasingly stretched financial and health human resources has spurred governments, policy makers, health service administrators, educational institutions and regulatory bodies alike to focus resources and attention on improving interprofessional team effectiveness.

With growing emphasis within the WRHA on the need to enhance team effectiveness, a standardized, evidence informed program aimed at improving and evaluating interprofessional collaborative care team performance is required. This program must be agile enough to apply to different types of teams practicing in diverse settings across the care continuum. This program must provide an evaluation platform for diagnosing current team functioning, a roadmap for improving teams within the WRHA and clearer direction as to those team-based interventions most likely to improve collaborative care.
