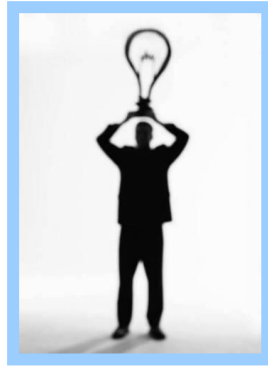

“Shining a Spotlight on Canadian Forces Health Services: Canada's 11th Healthcare System”

Presentation Overview: In many ways, the Canadian Forces Health Services (CFHS) can be considered Canada's 11th healthcare system. The CFHS serves military members throughout Canada and around the world in clinics, onboard ship, in the field, in remote locations and in war zones. To do so, it needs to be agile and innovative using cutting edge medicine and technology. At the same time, the CFHS needs to avail itself of services provided by the Provincial healthcare systems to ensure that the full spectrum of healthcare and training needs are met. This presentation will explore the interface between the military and provincial healthcare systems and how we can support and learn from each other.

Lieutenant Commander Roy has been with the Canadian Forces for over 30 years, where has she gained extensive experiences both nationally and internationally. She has held a variety of administrative positions including Naval Logistics Officer while at sea for 3 years, Comptroller for the Maritime Coastal Defence Vessel Project and for the Canadian contingent in the Golan Heights, and Director, Compensation and Benefits Administration. Since 2009, LCdr Roy has been the Commanding Officer of 23 CF Health Services Centre, Winnipeg.
