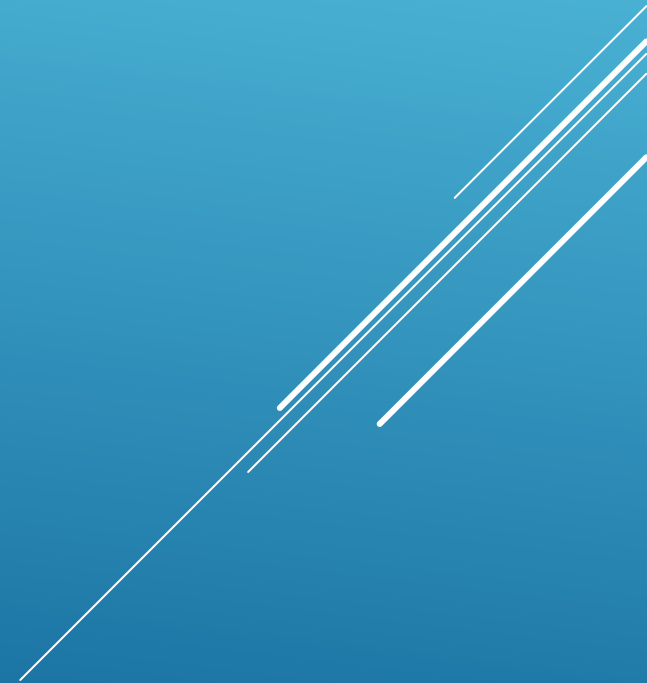

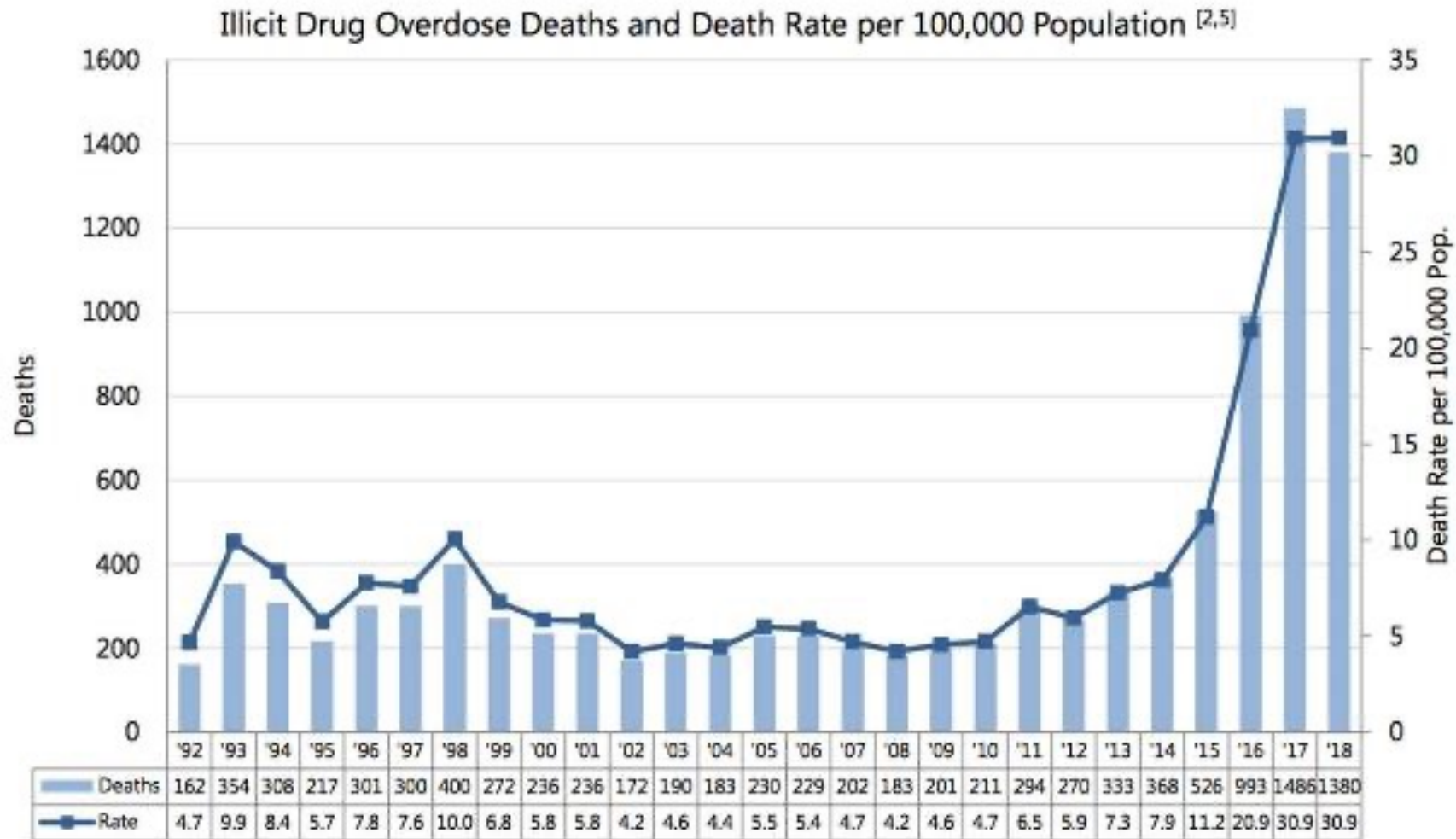

HOW DID THE HARBOUR COME TO BE?

SCS vs OPS

Supervised Consumption Services have an exemption to the Criminal Code of Canada for possession and consumption of illicit substances granted by Health Canada. There are several exemptions that are possible to receive.

Federal Network of SCS for knowledge exchange

Overdose Prevention Sites are designated by each Health Authority under the authorization of the Ministerial Declaration under the Emergency Health Act of BC in December, 2016.



- ▶ The Harbour SCS at 941 Pandora has several exemptions through Health Canada:
 - ▶ Injection
 - ▶ Intranasal
 - ▶ Oral
 - ▶ Peer assistance
 - ▶ Splitting/Sharing
 - ▶ Drug testing
 - ▶ Next Steps: Inhalation

▶ By the numbers (table):

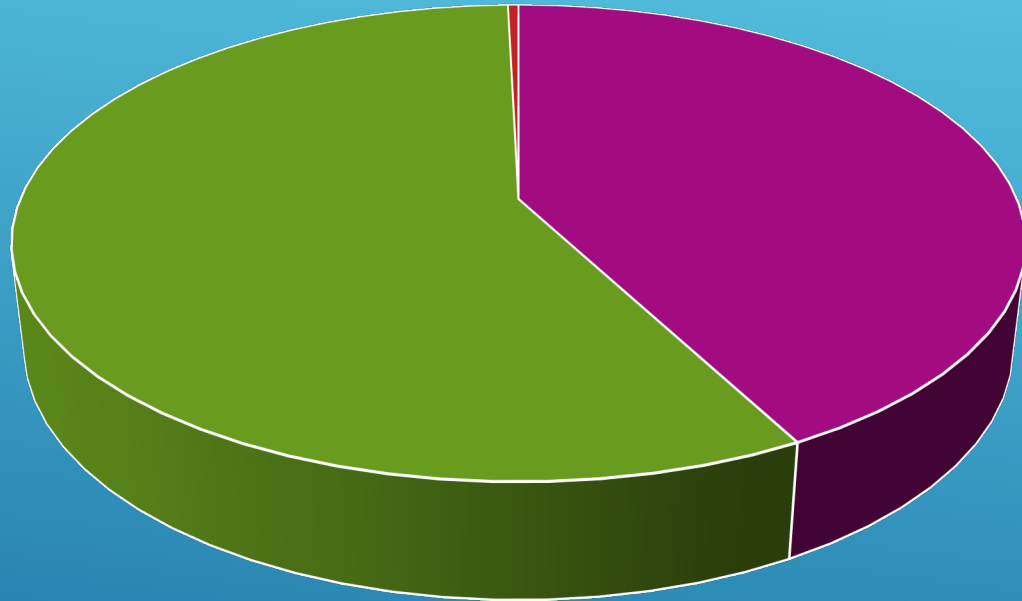
- ▶ More than 3500 unique participants have used our services
- ▶ Over 250,000 visits to date / Averaging ~145 visits per day between both sites
- ▶ Harm Reduction supplies given ~500,000 times / around 350 times per day
- ▶ Over 400 Substance poisonings have been reversed with 0 deaths

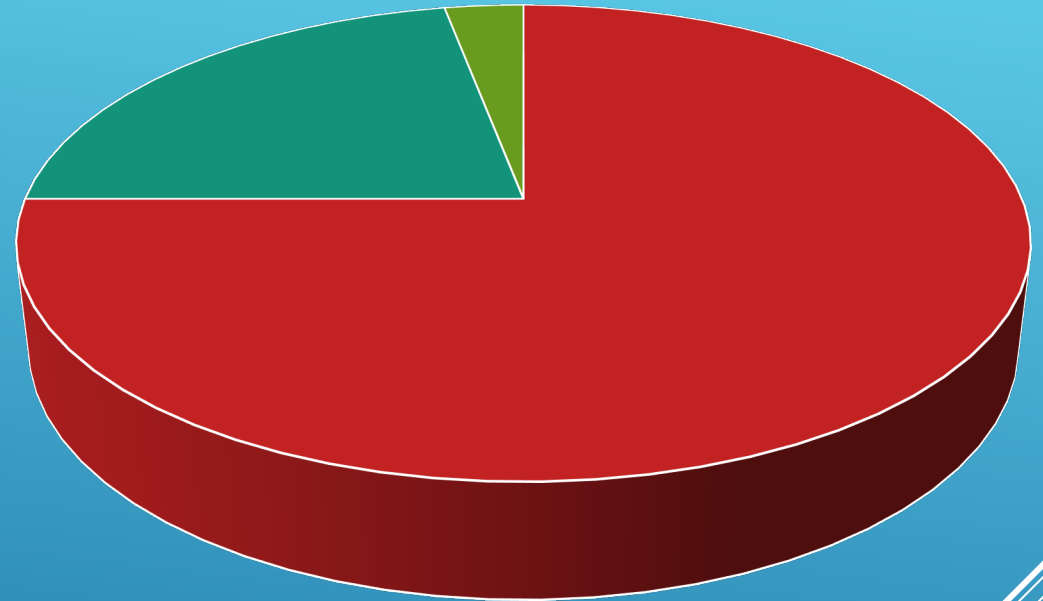

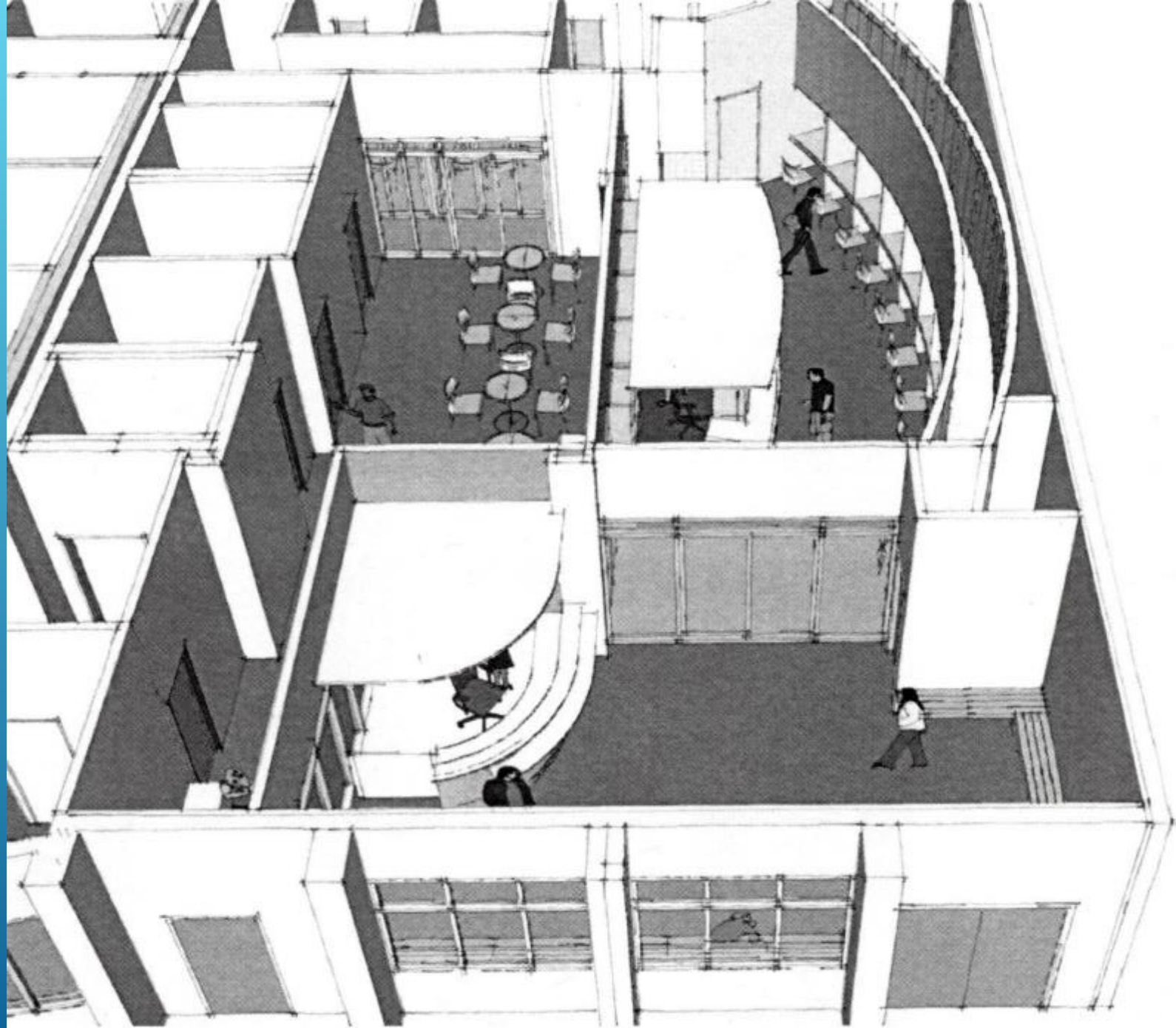

NURSE'S NOOK

THE HARBOUR PRESENTS: ISLAND HEALTH STREET OUTREACH NURSES!

Street Nurses can help you with:

- Testing, treatment, and referrals for chlamydia, gonorrhoea, syphilis, HIV, Hepatitis C
- Free immunisation for hepatitis A & B, influenza, tetanus/diphtheria, pneumococcal disease, HPV and more (some restrictions for publicly-funded patients)
- Women's health (pap tests, yeast/STI/trichomoniasis tests, some treatments, pregnancy tests and options counselling)
- Harm reduction education & supplies (safer injecting, vein maintenance services, safer smoking, take-home naloxone training and kits, condoms, etc)
- Wound care (for abscesses, cuts, burns, bites, blisters, etc)
- Some free over-the-counter medications
- Tuberculin skin (TST) skin tests or chest X-ray requisitions for detox entry
- Referrals to other health and social service programs & agencies
- Disease prevention, health promotion, and general health information
- **Street Nurses cannot write prescriptions**
