



- **2. SALES** All sponsorship and exhibit sales are final. Refunds will not be issued. Payment must be made in full prior to the event.
- **3. COMPETING EVENTS CLAUSE** Sponsors and exhibitors shall not host, sponsor, education seminars, outings, group activities, or similar events during the conference program without prior approval of CCHL. (The conference program hours include: Tuesday, October 24 from 12:00 pm 4:00 pm, Wednesday October 25 from 8:15 18:30 and Thursday, October 26 from 9:00 15:00 PST.)
