
REQUIREMENTS AND SCHEDULE 2020 – 2024 MOC BLOCK

- Prior to 2020 MOC I = 40 Total Credits (minimum of 7 MOC I credits)
- (2020) 33 Total Credits (minimum of 6 MOC I credits)
- (2021) **27** Total Credits (minimum of **5** MOC I credits)
- (2022) 21 Total Credits (minimum of 4 MOC I credits)
- (2023) 15 Total Credits (minimum of 3 MOC I credits)
- (2024) EXEMPT



MAINTENANCE OF CERTIFICATION





10 Engagement points = 1 MOC I credit

Posting on the Live Feed or Forums = 1 point Commenting on existing posts = 1 point Attending Events & Webinars = 10 points Mentorship = 5 points
