Halifax Convention Centre – Ballroom level – B1



3. COMPETING EVENTS CLAUSE – Sponsors, exhibitors, and advertisers shall not host, sponsor, education seminars, outings, group activities, or similar events during the conference program without prior approval of CCHL.
