2. SALES – All sales are final. Refunds will not be issued. Payment must be made in full prior to the event.

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT – This contract will terminate without liability to either party if substantial performance of either party's obligations is prevented by an unforeseeable cause reasonably beyond that party's control. Such causes include but are not limited to the following: acts of God, global pandemic; regulations or orders of governmental authorities; fire, flood or explosion; war, disaster, curtailment of transportation facilities; or other emergency making it illegal, or otherwise impossible to provide the facilities or the services to hold the event; any delay in necessary and essential construction or preparation of the meeting facility, strike, lockout or work stoppage or other restraint of labour, either partial or general, from whatever cause. CCHL will, in the event of impossibility of performance for any of the above, reimburse the sponsor on a pro-rata basis on any amount paid, less any and all legitimate expenses incurred, such as but not limited to rent, advertising, salaries and operating costs.


