#### Maintenance of Certification (MOC)





## **REQUIREMENTS AND SCHEDULE** 2020 – 2024 MOC BLOCK

- Prior to 2020 MOC I = 40 Total Credits (minimum of 7 MOC I credits)
- (2020) 33 Total Credits (minimum of 6 MOC I credits)
- (2021) 27 Total Credits (minimum of 5 MOC I credits)
- (2022) 21 Total Credits (minimum of 4 MOC I credits)
- (2023) 15 Total Credits (minimum of 3 MOC I credits)
- (2024) EXEMPT

### CREDITS AND QUALIFYING ACTIVITES MOC CATEGORY I CREDITS

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• One (1) credit for every hour of activity or educational content

#### 10 Engagement points = 1 MOC I credit

## WHAT'S NEXT?



#### **Fellowship Designation**

The CHE pathway towards the Fellowship designation was created to inspire lifelong learning and to promote health system impact. Applicants must meet the basic eligibility requirements as well as completing the following:

#### Health Leadership Specialties (HLS)

Individuals are required to complete formal learning on a health specialty followed by a practical application of learning and demonstrated impact.

#### **CCHL** Contribution

These contributions promote and encourage the participation in CCHL activities and events and ensure a diverse and broad group of eligible volunteers.



#### **CCHL Circle**

The online community where members can connect, learn, and develop. CHE members have access to the Advanced Leaders Group which offers even more specialized leadership development opportunities including micro-learning and ReadingEdge Leadership, both facilitated by leadership experts.

## WHAT'S NEXT?



#### **Mentorship Program**

Become a mentor and connect with emerging and experienced leaders that share the same interests. Participation in the CCHL's Mentorship program is a requirement to maintain your certification.



#### 1:1 Coaching

Continue your 1:1 coaching experience by exploring Coaching Bundles. Several options are available to best meet your and/or your organization's needs.



#### **Certified LEADS Specialist Certification (CLS)**

Having earned your LEADS Learning Series or equivalence via the CHE Select Program, the Certified LEADS Specialist Certification is perfect for any individual wishing to integrate LEADS into their organization, which allows their organization to be eligible to become fully LEADS licensed.
