The VP & CFO will also assume accountability for a support/clinical support portfolio and is responsible for ensuring that service delivery strategies align with the corporate mission and operating plan priorities.

- Exercises broad administrative responsibilities to provide direction and coordination of corporate and financial services and assigned support/clinical support services
- Assumes responsibility for the design, execution, and effectiveness of a system of internal controls, which provides assurance that operations are effective and efficient, and in compliance with applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures
- Ensures corporate and financial services are aligned with and in support of BGH's mission, vision, and strategic plan
- Ensures that quality assurance systems are in place across the corporation for the delivery of the highest standards of financial management and control; oversees the budgeting and audit processes and ensures that financial statements are prepared in accordance with all applicable standards and requirements
- In partnership with others, assumes responsibility for leading change through innovation and best practices
- Initiates, develops, and maintains cooperative relationships with community and regional partners, applicable government ministries, Ontario Health East staff and is responsible for closely monitoring compliance with provincial and federal financial regulatory requirements
