# **CCHL Launches Comprehensive Checklist to Address Health Human Resource Crisis**

In response to the ongoing Health Human Resource (HHR) crisis, the Canadian College of Health Leaders' 2024 National Conversation brought together experts, researchers, and members to dialogue and prioritize leadership actions required to address the HHR crisis. Consequently, CCHL has created a Checklist for Engaging and Empowering Health Human Resources, summarizing the actions taken by health leaders across Canada, and is now available and promises to provide actionable strategies for retaining current healthcare workers and preparing for an influx of younger professionals. The HHR crisis, exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic, has led to unprecedented levels of burnout, absenteeism, and turnover among healthcare workers. High patient workloads, resource scarcity, and fears for personal safety have placed immense pressure on the workforce.
