POSITION SUMMARY

This position works closely with all departments within the Northern Health Region to plan and implement Quality & Risk programs. The Director promotes the mission, values and goals of the NHR and participates actively in the NHR planning processes. The Risk Management portion of this portfolio reports to the VP Corporate Services & Chief Financial Officer. This position requires service and travel to outlying communities within the region and the province.

The incumbent must fulfill the requirements of the Criminal Records/ Vulnerable Person, Child Abuse Registry Check and Adult Abuse Registry Check, and adherence to all Northern Health Region policies and procedures.
